Report from your Peace Corps Advocate

This year saw a new Peace Corps record for congresspersons signing on to the Dear Colleague letter supporting funding for the Peace Corps - 175 signatures including 8 Republicans! CT and HI were the only states to have 100% sign on.

Please, please write, email or call your representative and thank him/her for their support. The reps really pay attention to constituent comments and are especially grateful for thanks since they get so much negative mail. If you are a constituent of Rosa DeLauro note that this is the 10th year she has signed on, an important anniversary of consistent support.

That's the good news, now the bad. The Peace Corps is in jeopardy! The administration's request for budget cuts includes a 30% slashing of the State Dept. and foreign aid and development programs. That includes Peace Corps and will result in fewer volunteers serving and fewer countries being served. Although my lobbying in Washington on March 2, the Peace Corps Day of Action went well and the Peace Corps is a bipartisan, feel good organization, not everyone is willing to put their money where their mouth is. Note that only 8 Republicans in Congress signed on to the funding letter.

We in CT are fortunate to have such strong support so we must congratulate our reps. We have a strong supporter in Sen. Chris Murphy who is on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee. He is advocating and alternative budget which will "plus up" Peace Corps funding. Make certain he knows that you as an RPCV have his back as he battles the anti foreign aid and development forces. Your own Peace Corps stories are especially effective as well as how your service has impacted what you do now as an RPCV.
