#### • Community Service Fund, Grants & Scholarships

- Maureen has been reviewing submissions, wants to ensure projects and grants are tied to sustainability.
- Board will revisit how money should be allocated per year based on number of project submissions & scholarship applications and how the endowment should be used. Should we allow people to choose where they donate using the new website? It cost about \$1500 to run CTRPCV a year that needs to be accounted for in annual spending.

- Project submission came in through Community Service Fund, request for \$2,000 –
  Hartford Catholic Worker they do after school activities and community work in an
  impoverished area in Hartford, they want to create an outdoor space with picnic
  tables so operations may continue through COVID. Board agreed to offer \$1,000, the
  remaining funds available for 2020 Community Service Grants.
- \$2,000 was given for Grow Good in the Neighborhood Gardening Project & \$1,000 was given for Soul de Cuba Cafe. We're at \$3,000 this year for community service funds expenses, we agreed to spend \$4,000 per year.
- We don't have any incoming source of money other than funds invested. We aren't fundraising.
- Scholarship the \$2,000 is supposed to come out of Vanguard endowment. We need to do more outreach about the scholarship to let people know it's available. We haven't received any interest. Al will reach out to schools around the state.
